The initial Siren signals would immediately inform the Staff and students inside or outside to stay in a building or go to a certain building or room in a building,

The Siren/Speaker system would inform the listeners what type of message system would be used for further information, be it Speakers, phone, cell phone, email or other types of messaging devices. Deaf people would be required to have some sort of vibrating, emergency messaging device supplied to them by the school, on them at all times and turned on at all times. I am not an expert in electronics but in this age of electronic wizardry many things can be implemented off of the Siren/Speaker system using messaging devices.

The Siren system would immediately send an emergency message to the local Fire Department, Law Enforcement and Campus Security the moment it is activated. There could be a provision for certain staff and teachers to have a handgun locked in a secure compartment in their desk. This compartment as well would only be electronically released/unlocked (when the Siren is activated) by an licensed officer/security officer in a heavily secured on Campus Security office room.
